

# Funky Chickens!

Finished size as shown will be 60 x 77.5 inches.



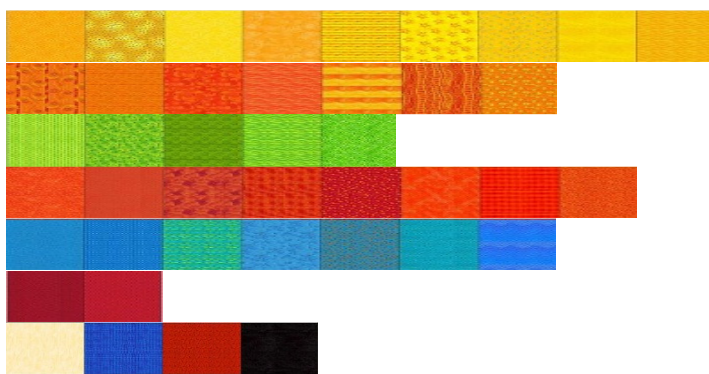
This scrap happy quilt can be made entirely from your stash, or from fat quarters.

If you are making your blocks entirely from fat quarters you will want to cut the block borders before your applique patches. When you follow the color chart below you will end up with 38 different fabrics. Cut a 2 ½ x 16 ½ strip from each. Then choose 10 of the fabrics to cut an additional strip from so that you have a total of 48. Set these aside and use them for the outside portions of your blocks. There is no need for a set color in each block border, so you can if you wish assemble these first.



Your base blocks will look like this. Background fabric is a 12 ½ square. Use the 2 ½ inch strips to picture frame the background.

Black inner sashing are 16 ½ x 2 inches – cut 31  
 Red sashing squares are 2 inches – cut 20  
 Blue Outer Borders – cut two 55 x 3 ½ inches  
 Blue Outer Borders – cut two 72 x 3 ½ inches



Yellows – 9 assorted fat quarters

Medium to Light Oranges – 7 assorted fat quarters

Lime Greens – 5 assorted fat quarters

Dark Oranges – 8 assorted fat quarters

Aqua to Teal – 7 assorted fat quarters

Reds – 2 assorted fat quarters

Background Fabric – 1 ½ yard

Outer Border Fabric – 1 yard

Sashing and Binding Fabric – 1 ¼ yard

Sashing Squares – ¼ yard
